A Biographical Sketch



Regina Lindsey is the director of economic development for the Greenspoint District and the executive director for the Greens Bayou Corridor Coalition (GBCC). The District was created by the State Legislature in 1991, at the request of commercial property owners and is funded through their assessments to provide services and improvements to ensure Greenspoint's growth and prosperity. The District has also been instrumental in spearheading the creation of other organizations, like GBCC, to establish additional opportunities for Greenspoint's development.

Organized in 2006, the GBCC is a 501(c)(3) dedicated to promoting infrastructure improvements along Greens Bayou that foster economic growth, improve quality of life and preserve green space. As executive director, Lindsey is the primary advocate for GBCC's mission, leading efforts to secure the funding and partnerships needed to implement projects.

Lindsey serves as a member of the Public Policy Advisory Committee for the International Economic Development Council. Previously, she served as executive director for the Silsbee Economic Development Corporation, with responsibility for developing relationships and marketing strategies to attract business to the area. In addition, she was Silsbee's mayor from 2003 to 2005. Before her roles in Silsbee, she was the executive director of the Southeast Texas Arts Council in Beaumont, TX.

Lindsey graduated Summa Cum Laude from Lamar University in Beaumont, TX with a bachelor's in History. In 2010, Lindsey earned the designation of Certified Economic Developer, a National recognition that denotes a mastery of principal skills in economic development. She was also president of the Silsbee Kiwanis Club, and a board member for Lamar Institute of Technology Regional Economic Development Initiative and the Southeast Texas Economic Development Foundation, which was responsible for administering SBA 504 loans. In addition, she served on the steering committee for the Southeast Texas Workforce Alliance and is a member of the Golden Triangle Hotel Motel Association and Press Club.

Regina resides in north Houston with her husband, Tracy. They are proud parents of daughters, Kayla and Krista.
