Diane Newman is controller and director of support services for the Greenspoint District. The District was created by the State Legislature in 1991, at the request of commercial property owners, and is funded through their assessments to provide services and improvements to ensure Greenspoint's growth and prosperity.

Newman joined the District in 1995 and oversees the District's finances and accounting, and records management. She is in charge of personnel, benefits administration and office administration.

An involved Greenspoint community member, Newman is on the board of directors of the Aldine-Greenspoint YMCA and serves as vice chair of the Lone Star College System Advisory Committee for the Office Technology Program. She is also a member of the Greater Greenspoint Human Resources Roundtable, the Houston Wellness Association and the Society of Human Resource Management.

Because of her commitment to Greenspoint, she was named the 1999 Volunteer of the Year for the Aldine-Greenspoint YMCA. Newman is also a 1999 graduate of Leadership North Houston, a 1997 graduate of the Harris County Citizens Police Academy and served as a volunteer for the March of Dimes WalkAmerica event in Greenspoint.

Newman's past community positions include serving as a member of the Aldine ISD Community Advisory Cabinet, a member of the Aldine Sr. High School Campus Improvement Steering Committee, secretary for the Aldine-Greenspoint YMCA Board of Directors, and treasurer of the North Houston Advisory Council.

Previously, Newman served as corporate services manager for an employment agency, and as a legal secretary. She received her training at the State University of New York at Binghamton/Harpur College, the Rochester Institute of Technology and North Harris College.
