

Jerry Lowry

A Biographical Sketch



Jerry Lowry is executive vice president and chief operating officer for the Greenspoint District. The District was created by the State Legislature in 1991, at the request of commercial property owners and is funded through their assessments to provide services and improvements to ensure Greenspoint's growth and prosperity.

Lowry oversees the District's Public Safety; Financial and Support Services; Planning, Operations and Infrastructure; and the Marketing and Public Affairs departments, with responsibility for the District's budget, administration, parks, mobility, streetscape and landscape maintenance programs and public safety initiatives. Lowry works closely with area law enforcement to build relationships with area businesses and residents to prevent crime and maximize quality of life.

In addition, Lowry also serves as executive director of the District's foundation, Greenspoint Community Partners (GCP). Established in 2004, GCP is a non-profit focused on gaining support to increase and expand District programs related to public safety, beautification, and recreational development.

Actively involved in the community, Lowry serves on the Amegy Bank Advisory Board, Assist the Officer Advisory Board, Leadership North Houston (LNH) board and is past chairman of the North Houston Greenspoint Chamber of Commerce (NHGCC). In 2008, Governor Rick Perry appointed Lowry to serve a six-year term on the Texas State Jail Standards Commission. Other honors Lowry has received include:

- NHGCC Pinnacle Award – 2000, 2005, 2006
- NHGCC Citizen of the Year – 2007
- LNH Distinguished Community Leader – 2007
- American Business Women Association Business Associate of the Year – 2007

Previously, Lowry served as a police officer and sergeant with the Houston Police Department, after which he moved into corporate security. Prior to joining the District, he co-owned an international security consulting firm with responsibility for management support, contract service bid management, investigations, physical assessments and crisis management policy development.

Lowry received his bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Houston-Downtown with Magna Cum Laude honors. Professional designations include Certified Protection Professional (CPP) from the American Society for Industrial Security and an Advanced Certificate from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education.

Lowry and his wife Cathy reside near Conroe, Texas where Lowry is a Pastor for the College Park Church of Christ and where he sits on the Heaven Sent Ministries Board of Directors.
