Kyle Kelley is field services and facility manager for the Greenspoint District. The District was created by the State Legislature in 1991, at the request of commercial property owners and is funded through their assessments to provide services and improvements to ensure Greenspoint's growth and prosperity.

In his position, Kelley is responsible for keeping the District's parks and properties clean, landscaped, and up to code. He will also identify mobility issues and manage current and future parks and trails.

With only a few days on the job, Kelley quickly identified key projects and areas within the District he plans to improve, including an area blighted by trash and illegal dumping.

Before joining the District, Kelley worked as an assistant superintendent at The Marsh Course at Kingwood Country Club. In his previous position, he oversaw pesticide applications and irrigation and horticultural management. He has also worked as a groundskeeper and project coordinator for numerous organizations, including the Houston Astros Baseball Club and the Texas Medical Center.

Kelley is director of the Region Eight Texas Turfgrass Association. He holds a bachelor's degree in Recreation, Parks, and Tourism Sciences from Texas A&M University.
